REV. JOSEPH HAYS was born in the state of Maryland, and removed, with his parents, to Ohio, where, in Ashland County, he was converted to God and joined the Methodist Episcopal Church. He was admitted on trial in the traveling connection in the North Ohio Conference in 1851, and appointed, as a colleague of Rev. J. T. Kellam, to Dalton Circuit. His work was afterward on Monroeville, Orville Mission, Millersburgh, and Sullivan Circuits, on the last of which his health failed and his labor ended. His ardent zeal in his Master's cause in seeking the salvation of sinners, prompted him to efforts beyond the strength of the frail body in which his self-denying, heavenly-minded spirit dwelt. Although his sickness was of a lingering, pulmonary character, yet his death was sudden. A heavenly calmness and serenity of spirit marked his sufferings and sweetened his conversation through all his sickness. The closing scene with Brother Hays well corresponded with his profession of a holy life and of a Christian minister. On the 17th of December, 1856, he bade adieu to the wife of his bosom, and exchanged the sorrows of earth for the bliss of heaven.
