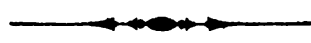
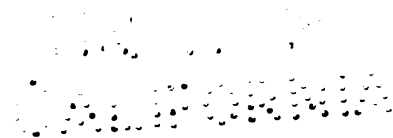

Quest. 11. *Who have died this year?*

REV. IRA M. HITCHCOCK was born in the state of New York in 1818. When young his father's family settled in northern Ohio, where, in 1842, he was converted to God. Soon after his conversion he was licensed to exhort and to preach. In 1850 he was recommended to the North Ohio Conference as a suitable person to be received on trial, and he was accordingly received and appointed in charge to the Orange Circuit, where he labored faithfully for two years. The next year he was appointed to Sullivan charge. During this year his health failed, and at the following conference he was placed on the superannuated list. At the succeeding conference he was appointed to the Olmstead Falls and Dover Circuit. Here he remained two years. His next charge was Brooklyn Circuit, where he remained about one year. His next and last appointment was to Amherst Circuit. This was a very laborious charge, but, anxious to meet the demands of the circuit, he toiled on till his system became enfeebled, disease set in, and for several months before our last conference he suffered from remittent fever, and from which he never but partially recovered. At our last conference he was again placed on the superannuated list.

Brother Hitchcock was well received, and very useful as a minister wherever he labored. He was a good preacher. He had an excellent mind well stored with various and useful knowledge, of agreeable manners, and a heart burning and glowing with the love of God. To his presiding elder, who visited him but a short time before his death, he said, "Tell my brethren of the conference, and all my friends, that I have no disposition to run after another Gospel; I am satisfied fully with the Gospel as taught by the Methodist Episcopal Church." And when told that "the blood of Jesus Christ his son cleanseth us from all sin," he replied, "O yes, precious promise!" Brother Hitchcock leaves a wife and five children, with numerous other friends who deeply mourn their loss.
