John Kisling was born September 16, 1794, in Wythe County, Va. He experienced converting grace when he reached his twenty-second year, and immediately joined the Methodist Epis-copal Church. For about nine years he served as a class leader and steward. In 1827 he moved to the State of Indiana. In 1831 he was licensed to preach, and in 1888 he was received into the South-east Indiana Conference, to labor in the German work. He was one of the most successful pioneers in that work, preaching with great fervency and power throughout Indiana, and especially in the southern part of it, which is thickly settled by Roman Catholics, many of whom were brought to a saving knowledge of the truth through this

In the year 1873 his wife, with whom he had lived fifty-seven years, died. In February, 1876, he visited his daughter in Pottawattanic, Iowa, and feeling ill he said, "I am near my eternal home." Often he gave utterance to such words as these: "O how precious is it to have Jesus when we near the river of death! Glorious hope to see Jesus! Glory! glory!" On the 3d of March, 1876, he fell gently asleep in Jesus. He was a good man. He truly rests from his labors and his works do follow his his works do follow him.
