Biographical/Historical note

Cora C. Kier Fulkerson was born 1872 December 29 in Vicksburg, Michigan. She married Dr. Clarke Fulkerson in Clarkston, Michigan 1902 June 25. Mrs. Fulkerson was an active member of the Methodist Episcopal Church, and was involved with several missionary societies including the Women's Foreign Missionary Society (WFMS), where she served as treasurer. WFMS was originally organized in Boston, Massachusetts in 1869. The main goal of the organization was to raise funds to send individuals to foreign countries to complete missionary work.

Mrs. Fulkerson died 1966 February 8.

Scope and Contents note

The **Cora Kier Fulkerson papers** document the life of Mrs. Fulkerson, specifically her involvement with religious and mission based organizations. The collection includes: correspondence, ephemera, clippings, programs, photographs, religious texts and devotionals, speeches written and presented by Mrs. Fulkerson, Summer School of Missions, and materials related to several women's missionary organizations.
