George Francis Tripp Diaries, 1889-1947

Biographical Note:

George Francis Tripp was born 13 March 1861 near Marine City, Michigan. He was admitted on trial to the Detroit Annual Conference in 1887 and became a full member in 1890, becoming and ordained Elder in 1892. He married Stella Violetta Dale, the organist at one of his churches, on 4 January 1893. After his retirement, he served as a supply minister in the Flint area even into his eighties. On 20 June 1948, he was presented with the Detroit Conference Cane by Rev. Floyd Porter with Bishop Raymond J. Wade present. He died 25 March 1949 in Flint, Michigan.

This collection contains a set of diaries covering various years between 1889 and 1947.
