Helen Louise Royce Personal Papers, 1947-1972

Biographical Note:

Helen Royce was born 3 December 1900 in Waterbury, Connecticut. Through the Blakeslee Training School in New Haven, Connecticut, she took classes for graduate students in Religious Education at Yale Divinity School, but did not receive her Master's degree. She was ordained in Rochester, New York in 1937. She came to Michigan in 1939 and began doing mission work in Detroit. She served churches in Caseville, Bentley, Mio, Glennie, the Cass River Circuit, and retired from the church in Millersburg in 1967. After her retirement, she served as an associate pastor in Clawson and Flint. She died in Chelsea, Michigan on 22 August 1989.
