James Edward Jacklin

Personal Papers, 1866-1930

Biographical Note:

Rev. James E. Jacklin was born on 1 January 1847 in Blissfield, Michigan and died in Detroit, Michigan on 2 November 1943. After serving at several churches early in his career, he was appointed Associate Editor of the *Michigan Christian Advocate*. Later he was instrumental in the establishment of the Old People's Home at Chelsea.

Scope Note:

This small collection contains fragments that document some aspects of his career in part. Included are certificates, notebooks, scrapbooks, historical articles, and a record of the baptisms and funerals he conducted.

Extent:

0.8 linear feet (ca. 1,600 pages)
