John A. Eversole was born 1912 July 23. He graduated from Otterbein College (Westerville, Ohio) in 1936 and continued his edutation at the Evangelical Theological Seminary, earing a degree in 1942 and earning a Master of Sacred Theology at Oberlin College in 1951.
