

# Franklin William Stephenson Personal Papers, 1899-1972

#### **Biographical Note:**

Franklin Stephenson was born 29 June 1882 in Franklin, Michigan. In 1906, he graduated from Adrian College and was ordained a minister. He received a Bachelor's degree in Sacred Theology from Westminster Seminary in Maryland (now Wesley Seminary in Washington, D.C.) in 1913. He was awarded a Doctor of Divinity degree in 1926 and was inducted into the John Wesley Society of the Wesley Theological Seminary in 1928. He served at churches in North Branch, Owosso, and Lansing before leaving the state. In 1959, he returned to Adrian College to serve as assistant to President John Dawson. At this time, he also served as interim pastor of the West Adrian Congregational Church for four years before retiring to Florida. He was married three times: to Jennie Mabel Darling from 29 June 1910 until her death in 1956; to Elsie Bradshaw from 1 November 1959 to her death in 1965; and to Faye Mollan from 2 September 1967 until his death on 22 April 1976 in Lansing, Michigan.

### **Scope Note:**

This collection contains two series: a set of diaries covering 1899 through 1919, 1921 through 1939, 1965 through 1966, and 1968 through 1972; and a series of his personal writings.

#### **Extent:**

5.2 linear feet (ca. 10,400 pages)
