Western Michigan Conference Methodist Protestant Church Records, 1858-1893

History Note:

The Methodist Protestant Church had two conferences in Michigan for much of the 19th century - the Michigan Conference and the Western Michigan Conference - but eventually they merged into a single conference. After the 1939 merger with the Methodist Episcopal Church, the Michigan Methodist Protestant churches joined the Detroit and Michigan Conferences of the Methodist Church.

Scope Note:

The collection contains annual conference journals and deacon's certificates. In addition to these records, the Archives hold published Western Michigan Conference journals (1878-1905) in either hard copy or microfilm.

Extent:

0.6 linear foot (ca. 1,200 pages)

Access Restrictions:

The collection is open to research.
