# Woman's Home Missionary Society of the Methodist Episcopal Church (Ann Arbor and West Detroit Districts) Records, 1898-1918

**History Note:**

The national Woman's Home Missionary Society was founded in Cincinnati, Ohio in 1880 with a central focus on social welfare of poor people in the United States. The Detroit Conference society and those of its districts focused on the work of the Detroit Deaconess Home and other projects to help the urban poor. This district was originally known as Ann Arbor District, but was renamed the West Detroit District in 1916.

The collection contains meeting minutes and reports.
